The September 1, 2015 meeting was reconvened at 6:00 p.m. with the following trustees present Akers-yea; Volpe-yea; and Shively-yea.

A motion by Volpe was made to accept the contract from Shelly & Sands, Inc. for the project known as DEL-TR-56-1.45 Wilson Road Improvements. The amount of the total contract is \$369,924.00, with OPWC paying approximately \$227,920, The Delaware County Engineer paying approximately \$50,000, and Kingston Township paying the balance of \$92,004. The estimated date of completion for the project is June 30, 2016. A second was made by Akers. Vote: Akers-yea; Volpe-yea; and Shively-yea.

A motion by Volpe was made to authorize a 5% increase in pay for the Kingston Township Trustees and the Fiscal Officer beginning January 2016, and another 5% increase for the elected officials beginning January 2017. This will be for the elected officials whose term will be expiring November 2015. No raises have been given to the elected officials for a period of time.

A motion by Volpe was made to approve compensation to Daniel Kaiser in the amount of \$5,035.00 for the purpose which is necessary for an easement on the Wilson Road Improvement project. A second was made by Akers. Vote: Akers-yea; Volpe-yea; and Shively-yea.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned until October 6, 2015 the next regular Kingston Township Board of Trustees meeting.
