The Kingston Township Board of Trustees Monthly Board of Trustees Meeting was called to order by Chairman Volpe.

FINANCE: The Bank Reconciliation for July 2016 was presented for approval. A motion by Akers was made to accept the financial reports as presented by the Fiscal Officer. A second was made by Volpe. Vote: Volpe-yea; Shively-absent, and Akers-yea.

OLD BUSINESS: The contract with Waste Management will expire on 12-31-2016. Akers to check with the Delaware County Prosecutor on possibly amending the current contract with Waste Management.

It was noted that the extended portion of Basham Lane right-of-way in Kingston Township is to be mowed by Kingston Township. This will continue to be maintained by Kingston Township.

NEW BUSINESS:

PORTER-KINGSTON FIRE DISTRICT – Akers gave a report on the Fire District.

PUBLIC INPUT: a few residents of Kingston Township who reside on or near Wilson road attended the meeting to discuss their concerns about the traffic, speeding, and how dangerous the roads have become. Volpe to arrange a meeting with the Delaware County Sheriff and the residents to discuss the problems. A date will be determined. This will not be a “Special” township meeting but a resident meeting with the local law enforcement.
