MINUTES:

The Minutes for the Regular Board meeting on June 1, 2021 and the Special Meeting held on June 8, 2021 were reviewed by the trustees. A motion to approve the minutes as submitted was made by Shively. A second was made by Akers. Vote: Akers-yea and Shively-yea.

OTHER BUSINESS:


