ZONING REPORT:

Zoning Inspector Talbott highlighted several items in the November and December 2014 and January 2015 Trustee Reports *referenced as Item 1* including the number of permits issued, the resolution of all complaints for 2014, a new barking dog complaint on Todd Street Road in which the County Prosecutor’s Office reaffirmed that the Township Noise Ordinance does include barking dogs, and several board vacancies that are posted.

Two newspaper articles, *referenced as Items 2 and 3*, were distributed to Members including the status of the proposed merger between the Village of Galena and Berkshire Township dated January 14, 2015 from The Delaware Gazette, and the potential withdrawal of the Village of Galena from Berkshire Township dated January 15, 2015 from The Delaware Gazette. A summary of a meeting sponsored by the League of Women Voters held on January 14, 2015, *referenced as Item 4*, was also distributed. The meeting focused on the funding mechanisms being used to finance the proposed Simon-Tanger Outlet Mall and infrastructure improvements. A brief discussion took place regarding a lawsuit filed in Delaware County to put an approved Joint Economic Development District (JEDD) between Berkshire Township and the City of Delaware on the November ballot for voter action.
